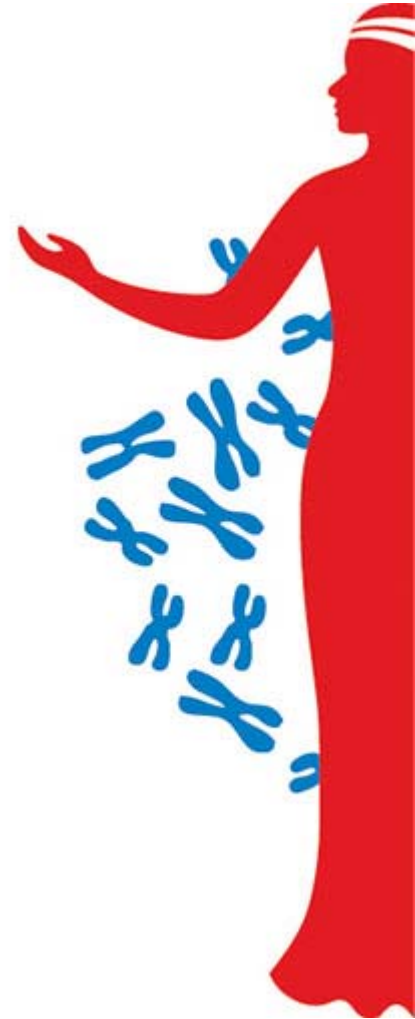
Moving Into the Future – New Dimensions and Strategies for Women's Health Research for the National Institutes of Health
